- Israel Data for Kerosene include Jet Fuel.
- Italy includes San Marino and the Holy See.
- Japan includes Okinawa.
- *Kuwait* The data for crude petroleum production include 50 per cent of the output of the Neutral Zone.
- Madagascar data for bitumen include petroleum coke.
- *Netherlands* excludes Suriname and the Netherlands Antilles. Data for petroleum coke are confidential for the period 2006-2007.
- Netherlands Antilles comprises Bonaire, Curaçao, Saba, St. Eustatius and the Dutch part of St. Martin.
- Norway includes Svalbard and Jan Mayen Islands.

- Pacific Islands (until 1991) comprises Federated States of Micronesia, Marshall Islands, Northern Mariana Islands and Palau.
- *Portugal* includes the Azores and Madeira.
- Saudi Arabia The data for crude petroleum production include 50 per cent of the output of the Neutral Zone.
- Serbia Data exclude Kosovo.
- Spain includes the Canary Islands.
- *Switzerland* includes Liechtenstein for oil statistics. Data for other fuels do not include Liechtenstein
- *Ukraine* For confidentiality reasons, the production of the following products is not available: lignite (2007-2010), lignite briquettes (2008-2010), hard coal briquettes (2002-2010), kerosene and petroleum coke (2002-2010), aviation gasoline (2009-2010) and jet fuel (2009-2010), white spirit (2006 and 2008-2010), and petroleum waxes (2009).
- *United States* includes the 50 states and the District of Columbia. Oil statistics as well as coal trade statistics also include Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Johnston Atoll, Midway Islands, Wake Island and the Northern Mariana Islands.
- *United Kingdom* includes Jersey and Guernsey for oil statistics. It excludes these islands for electricity.
